More than 1200 preschool children subscribed to “The Naughty Mynah” this April!



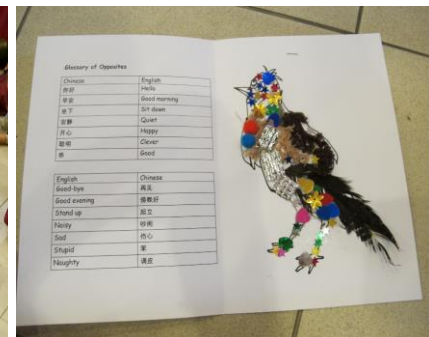
The Naughty Mynah is produced by The Learning Connections (TLC) and directed by Ng Hui. It is the first bilingual storytelling performance for preschool children aged 3 – 6 years under its Story Box series. Children from preschools island-wide had a sensational time watching Evelyn Wong’s book come ‘alive’ in a fun, interactive storytelling performance that uses both English and Mandarin to engage our young audience!

The Naughty Mynah helps young children develop an appreciation for the Mandarin language and the diverse language environment they live in. Through the concepts of “translation” and “opposites”, the children are encouraged to think about the role and importance of bilingualism in their daily lives. The use of puppetry, drama, storytelling, songs and movements added with a dose of mischief and humor to bring this book to life made this learning journey exciting and enjoyable for children and adults!
