A multi arts experience to tell a story

Once Upon a Storytime is an approved National Arts Council - Arts Education Programme (NAC-AEP) for preschool children 4 – 6 years. It is interactive and collaborative storytelling performance between the performer and the children. The performer uses the “Teacher-in-role” technique and invites the children to participate through various art forms (drama, music and movements) during the story telling journey. This interactive and participative approach to storytelling serves as a stimulus for children to explore and discuss issues that are relevant to themselves and the world that they are living.
