## **Drama for Learning - The Use of Drama in the Early Years Curriculum (3-hr introductory workshop)**

Through this workshop, teachers will develop an understanding and appreciation of the value of drama in early childhood settings. They will learn how to ignite and expand children's imagination to spark meaningful explorations of the NEL 6 learning domains (Language & Literacy, Numeracy, Discovery of the World, Motor Skills Development, Aesthetics and Creative Expression, Social-Emotional Development) by using simple drama strategies such as the 'Teacher-in-role' (TiR) technique.

Goal: At the end of the workshop, teachers will be able to appreciate the role of drama and apply it as a vehicle for teaching and learning in a variety of settings.

Goal: At the end of the workshop, teachers will be able to examine literature and drama strategies that promote children's social-emotional development, with an emphasis on kindness, empathy, and respect for self and others.
